



## IMPORTANT SAFETY REMINDER

### SAFE HANDLING OF COREGAS MULTI CYLINDER MODULE PACKS

---

Coregas reminds you of the need to ensure the safe handling of Coregas 6-packs, especially in cases where uneven ground and inexperienced forklift operators are involved.

Please ensure that you follow these practices in handling multi cylinder module packs:

- Modules should be transported only when securely strapped with a minimum of 3 webbing straps. Please contact us for specific restraining instructions.
- Module cylinders should not be removed from module pallets.
- Modules should be moved using a forklift only.
- When moving a 6-pack with a forklift, the tines should reach fully through the module so support is provided to the framework of the pack.
- Modules should be handled carefully to avoid frame or manifold damage.
- The weight distribution on forklift tines should be even to avoid instability.
- Modules should be stored on solid, level ground.
